Law, Societies, and Justice Admission Requirements:

Admission is competitive, focusing on: GPA, with emphasis on grades in courses required for admission and major requirements; essay representing interest in the LSJ major; and other evidence of commitment to the study of society, justice, and law. Students may apply in Autumn, Winter, or Spring. Applications are due the 2 nd Friday of the quarter by 4pm. Students are notified of admission decisions by the 6 th week of the quarter in which they apply. Apply online: lsj.washington.edu/applying-lsj-major . Beginning AUT 17: first time applicants may apply only twice and are required to take TWO core courses as pre-requisites.
